


3 ways electricity is better than oil

3. ENERGY SECURITY: <u>DOMESTIC</u> --Only 1.5% of electricity comes from oil in US



Modified from an EDTA diagram concept





- <u>Felix Kramer</u>: 11,269 miles@62MPG (ten R/T to Tahoe, dozens of 80+ miles in Bay Area; plus 4,300 local miles with Leaf)
- <u>Long distances</u>: 225 miles to & from Tahoe (full battery, 8,000 ft. elevation): 35.8MPG up, 50.8MPG down, av. 43MPG First plug-in to drive it w/out refueling!



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
